

WSKW Student Presentation Grant

Eligible students are encouraged to apply for grant funding related to attending the 2022 WSKW Annual conference. Students may be recognized annually during the Conference with a certificate and waiver of registration fee.

WSKW offers Conference Grant awards to cover the WSKW conference registration fee, and a one year membership fee, for Kinesiology and allied health students to attend the annual WSKW conference at which they are presenting. See below for more information about eligibility requirements and instructions to apply. Conference grants are DUE reviewed within 60 days of the conference date.

Students are eligible for one conference grant per year.

Eligibility

- Be enrolled, and in good standing, as an undergraduate or graduate in a Kinesiology or allied health program in the term in which they are planning to attend the conference, or have graduated from a Kinesiology or allied health program in the previous academic term.
- Be in good academic standing.
- Be presenting a paper or poster at the conference.
- Attending the WSKW Conference on Thursday & Friday, Oct. 6 and 7th, 2022.

To Apply

Students applying should submit the following in **an e-mail to Jennifer Sherwood, Ph.D. BEFORE Friday, 23rd September 2022, by 5 pm Pacific Time:**

- SUBJECT LINE: YOUR LAST NAME, WSKW Conference Grant Application
- Copy of unofficial transcript showing academic standing in previous term
- < 300 word statement summarizing their plans to attend/present at the annual meeting
- draft of their conference itinerary indicating the sessions that they are planning to attend over the Thursday and Friday during the Conference.

Selection

The President will assess the quality of the applications, and with the agreement of the Executive Committee will select up to five (5) recipients to receive the Conference awards. The number of student awards may depend on the number of applications received. Students awardees will be selected based on:

- Unofficial transcript evidence to be in good academic standing in previous academic term
- Evidence in the student personal statement that they are presenting at the Annual Conference, and of their plans to attend and participate in the Annual Conference
- Preference will be given to applicants from institutions not represented in the previous year's awards.

Award Timeline

- All application material must be submitted before Friday, 23rd September 2022, by 5 pm Pacific Time.
- The President reviews applications and selects recipients to be presented, with materials made available, to the WSKW Executive Committee Executive Committee.
- Applicants will be notified of their status by Oct. 1.
- Awardees will be presented their certificate of award during the WSKW Conference Award Ceremony on Thursday, Oct. 6th, 2022.
